REQUIREMENTS

II QUALIFICATIONS

- A. A Diploma in Information Technology or Computer Science or an equivalent qualification acceptable by the Board.**
- B. (i) reckon at least three years' proven experience in a similar position;**
(ii) possess good interpersonal and communication skills;
(iii) possess a critical and analytical mind and have a multi-disciplinary approach to problem-solving; and
(iv) demonstrate knowledge in the creative industries in the local and international context.

IV SCOPE OF SERVICES

1. To design and implement the social media platforms including the website and/or any future means of digital contents;
2. To operate the internal system regarding data analysis, selection, matching, and finalisation of operations on the overall process of documentation (for both membership and repertoire);
3. To perform tasks in relation to the documentation of the Society on the IPI, WID, CIS-NET and similar international networks;
4. To assist in all matters relating to software applications and in resolving effectively all problems relating to IT equipment;
5. To install and configure software applications on workstations; troubleshoot problems with computer systems and make repairs and corrections accordingly;

6. To act as a technical resource person in assisting users to resolve problems with equipment and data management;
7. To prepare back-up for audit exercises;
8. To prepare specifications for procurement exercises and to liaise with service providers of the internal systems and other software solutions; and
9. To prepare technical reports as and when required.

NOTE: The ICT Technician on contract is required to work outside office hours including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays as and when required.
